Background:

3.5" Spool is made of 100% recycled polyethylene, and the material is wound on to the spool, placed in a carton of 2.

Objective:

- Must be in a pack of 2
- Must dispense the product easily
- Use sustainable materials
- Ease of identification on individual packaging
